

## Scholarship

### Eligibility

To be eligible to participate in the proceeds from the fund, each applicant must:

- (1) Be a member of Most Blessed Sacrament Parish.
- (2) Must be an active member of the Parish High School Ministry Program.
- (3) Have contributed their time and talent to the Parish community of Most Blessed Sacrament.

Applicant's academic merit or financial need will not be used to determine eligibility.



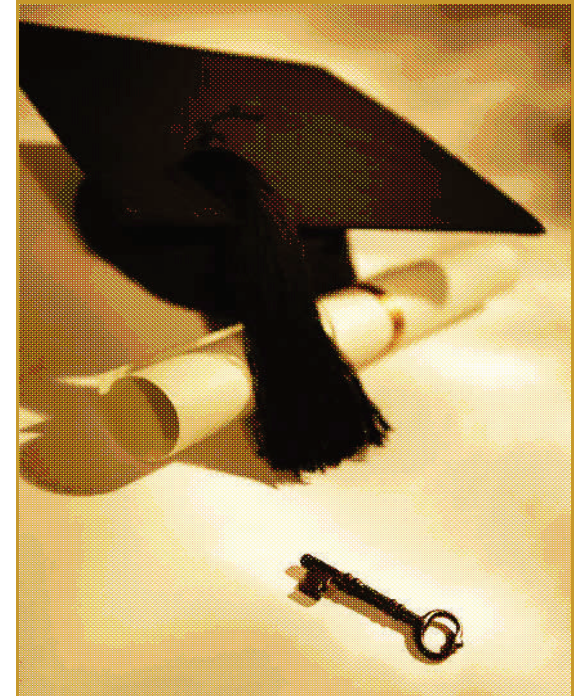

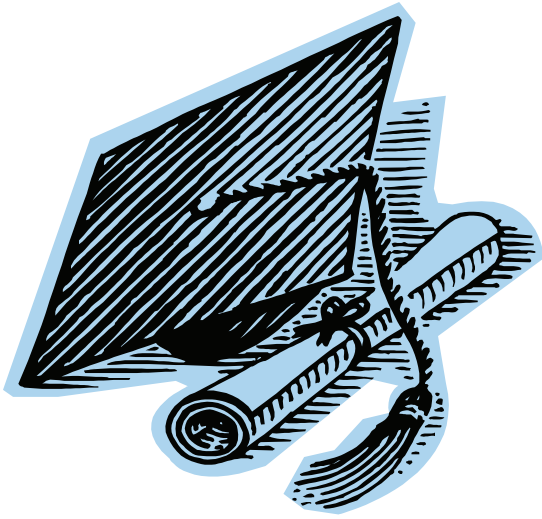

## Parish Scholarship Fund

A Parish Scholarship fund was established in 2006, named in honor of parish members Deacon Fred and Mrs. Olivia Toca who helped create the scholarship fund at Most Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church.

The fund is established to encourage graduating high school senior members of the Most Blessed Sacrament Parish family to continue their education and training beyond the high school diploma, and to provide assistance with some related expenses.



## Restrictions on Use of Funds

The scholarship fund has no restrictions on the institution to be attended — any academic, art, business, craft, trade, vocational, or any other source of education or training beyond high school qualifies.

The scholarship fund has no restrictions on the use to which proceeds may be put by the applicant — tuition, books, living or incidental expenses qualify.

## Duration

Each eligible applicant may receive an award from the scholarship fund only during the first year of attendance at an institution beyond high school.

## Distribution

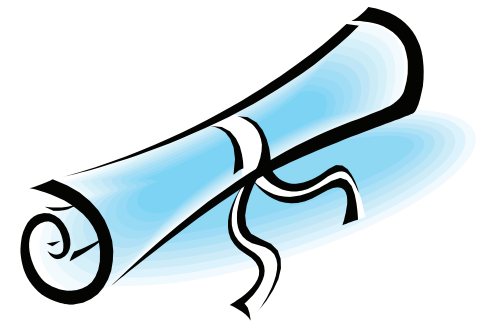
All graduating high school senior members of Most Blessed Sacrament Parish who have been active in the High School Ministry Program may submit their name to the Pastor or High School Youth Minister to receive an award from the scholarship fund. The proceeds from the fund will be available on the second Sunday in June of each year.

## Operation of the Fund

The Most Blessed Sacrament Scholarship Fund is supported by the people of Most Blessed Sacrament Parish through Sunday offerings (second collections) in the Spring and Fall, and by private donations made by individuals. An envelope for the scholarship fund is attached and are also available in the Narthex of the church.

Each year a scholarship gift will be awarded to all eligible applicants as equal shares.

The scholarship fund is maintained as part of the Most Blessed Sacrament Deposit and Loan Fund in a separate account of the Archdiocese Deposit and Loan Fund and under the direction of the Pastor, Finance Council and Parish leadership.
